

Qualifying for the 2026 BC Men's or Women's Championship



IMPORTANT DATES

- November 23 - Preliminary Registration/Payment due
- November 24 - CTRS Points Cutoff
- December 1 - CTRS ranking determined and qualifying teams announced
- December 4-7 - Open Qualifier, Victoria
- December 8 - Championship Registration/Final Payment due
- December 9 - Championship Rosters announcement
- December 29 - January 4 - Men's and Women's Championship

PATHWAYS TO QUALIFY

Men's:

- 1 Defending Champion - Team must have a minimum of 3 players returning from the 2025 BC Championship roster otherwise this becomes an additional CTRS berth
- 8 Teams Canadian Team Ranking System
- 3 Teams Open Qualifier

Women's:

- 1 Defending Champion - Team must have a minimum of 3 players returning from the 2025 BC Championship roster otherwise this becomes an additional CTRS berth
- 5 Teams Canadian Team Ranking System
- 2 Teams Open Qualifier

PROCESS

- Any team wanting the chance to qualify for the Championship must register and pay the Preliminary fee for the Open Qualifier before November 23, 2025.
- Teams that qualify through CTRS or are the Defending Champion will not be required to play in the Open Qualifier, but must register and pay the Preliminary Fee.
- Each team that qualifies for the Championship will pay the additional Championship Registration fee before December 8, 2025.

FEES

- \$300+gst - Preliminary Registration fee
 - this fee is for every team trying to earn a berth in the BC Championship either by defending champion, CTRS or Open Qualifier
- \$300+gst - Championship Registration fee
 - this fee is for teams that have earned a berth to the BC Championship
