

Host Club Responsibilities- Coaching Courses

To provide professional educational development we ask that the club provide the following:

- Donated Ice Time
 - Ice needs to be pebbled and usable for slide/sweeping demonstrations.
- Quiet meeting room space with tables and chairs
 - Friday Night MED Workshop approx. 3 Hours *for Competition Coach Workshop
 - Saturday & Sunday Workshops (ie: between 9am-5pm each day)
- A digital projector or an LCD/LED TV with VGA cables
 - please notify Curl BC if you do not have access to a projector
- **WIFI Access**
 - Please provide the details for the course conductor and attendees to access WIFI during the workshop.
- Flip chart paper with felt pens or white board with dry erase markers (where possible)
- Curling Club Waivers to send to participants, or remind to sign at the workshop.

Participants or the club are required to pay a registration fee which will cover the following costs:

- All course related materials
- Instructor fees and travel costs
- Curling Canada and Coaching Association of Canada certification fees

Specific workshop options and requirements:

Club Coach

- Club Coach 2 days (ie: Saturday & Sunday 9am-5pm)
- One to two sheets of ice for approximately 2 hours each day is required.
 - Meeting Space/Ice times to be negotiated with Curling club & facilitator for scheduling purposes.

Competition Coach

- Competition Coach 2-2.25 days (Friday 3 Hour MED workshop, Saturday & Sunday 9am-5pm)
- The workshop can be offered over a single weekend or split over two weekends.
 - Friday evening 3 hour MED Workshop (off ice) 6pm-9pm
 - Saturday and Sunday 9am-5pm is most common format
- One to two sheets of ice for approximately 2 hours each day is required.
 - Meeting Space/Ice times to be negotiated with Curling club & facilitator for scheduling purposes.

Club Coach Youth

- Club Coach Youth 1 Day (ie: 9am-5pm)
- One to two sheets for approximately 2 hours is required.
 - Approx. 1 sheet for 6 participants

 - 1 Complimentary registration to the course (valued at \$204.40)
 - In-Kind benefit
 - Trained Competition Coach that can qualify to take teams into playdown events
 - 1 year exemption may be given to accompany teams as Competition Coach trained.
 - After the 1 year exemption the Coach would be required to complete the on-ice evaluation
 - Compensation for meeting room space
 - \$50 with a minimum of 12 participants registered
 - Compensation for ice usage:
 - \$50 with a minimum of 12 participants registered
 - Food & Beverage Revenue
 - \$45/person for the 2.5 day course
 - If your facility has these services it is a direct benefit.
 - Otherwise this is a community benefit
