Age Description	Minimum age is 11 years as of December 31, 2021. Must be 15 years of age or under as of December 31, 2021.
Zone Composition	One team of 5 competitors per zone

Coaches: (See BC Games General Rules for information about the "adult supervisor" role.	<p>One head coach and one assistant coach per zone (at least one must be female).</p> <p>Every zone must name a head coach and at least one assistant coach (exception: sports for athletes with a disability, which must have one head coach and at least one assistant coach for the sport). If additional adults are named for the zone (or sport) and they meet the certification requirements of assistant coaches, they should be registered with the role "assistant coach", otherwise they are registered with the role "adult supervisor". Athlete Eligibility In addition to BC Games General Rules, the sport-specific eligibility requirements noted in this technical package are in effect for the 2022 BC Winter Games.	<p>All athletes must be members affiliated with Curl BC. All competitors can only qualify for the zone in which they make their permanent residence, not where they register to compete. Athletes who qualify for a U18 and/or a U21 Curling Provincial Championship and reach the podium will not be eligible for a 2nd BC Winter Games. Athletes who qualify for the Canada Winter Games will not be eligible for a 2nd BC Winter Games.</p>

Coaching Eligibility
Note that the role of head coaches and assistant coaches at the BC Games includes travelling to and from the Games with the team/zone, residing with the team/zone in BC Games accommodation, and acting in a supervisory capacity throughout the Games.
See BC Games General Rules for information about the roles of the head coach and assistant coach.

All coaches must be fully certified as an NCCP Competition Coach or Level 2 Coach and complete the NCCP Safe Sport Training. Assistant coaches must be competition coach trained and have complete Making Ethical Decisions and the NCCP Safe Sport Training.

BC Games General Rules dictate the level of coach certification required for head coaches and assistant coaches unless otherwise stated in this Technical Package - click here for details. A minimum of Safe Sport Training is required for all adult supervisors and coaches - more information can be found at [here](https://safesport.coach.ca)..

Events and Categories

Zone Selections and Registration Deadline
