

## **Curling BC Ranking List Criteria**

The categories of athletes that are considered for ranking include men, women, junior men, and junior women, Mixed Doubles and Wheelchair. Athletes are ranked individually and points are awarded based on performance in the last four years of competition.

- Team points are divided by four and awarded to each player on the team.
- Points will be retained for two years.
- 5<sup>th</sup> players who play more than 2 games on a rotating player team will receive points
- 5<sup>th</sup> players who play less than 2 games will not receive points
