- Recommend which officials are assigned to zone, inter-zone, BC Championships, and Multi-Sport events and liaises with the HP & Competitions Manager.
- Collaborate with the Competitions Manager to prepare and update Team Briefing Document templates.
- Update the Chief Umpire Manual in coordination with Curl BC's Competitor Guide.
- Receives, reviews, and maintains evaluation on Supervisors and Chief Umpires
- Provides assistance to competition committees to ensure rules are up-to-date
- Encourages officials to upgrade their certification in accordance with Curl BC policy
- Advises all provincial and zone officials of any changes to Curling Canada (CC) rules or rule interpretations.
- Annually host a fall officiating updates webinar for all officials assigned to events during the upcoming season.
- Reviews and signs all officiating Practical Forms and submits to Education & Youth Development Manager
- Collaborate with the BC Education Officiating Coordinator
- Conduct an annual review of the resource documents for officials, and provides any updates as necessary in collaboration with the BC Competition Officiating Coordinator.
