### **Areas of Responsibility**

- Collaborates with the Education & Youth Development Manager to provide ice technician training opportunities
  - Determines which course conductors are assigned to each requested location
- Collaborates with the Education & Youth Development Manager to plan seasonal mentorship opportunities
  - Minimum of 1 event annually (virtually or in-person)
- Advocate for ice technicians to participate in the level 3 ice technician program.
- Collaborate with the Provincial Ice Technician for mentorship opportunities at championship events
- Conduct an annual review of the resource documents for ice technicians and provides any updates as necessary.
- Provide consultations or on-site assistance as required to Curl BC Member Facilities.
- Partner with industry organizations to provide additional professional development opportunities.
