Job Description:

The Wheelchair Curling Coordinator (WCC) assists with scheduling and delivering wheelchair curling training and development opportunities throughout the province of BC. The WCC will report directly to the Member Services Manager. The candidate will have experience with wheelchair curling as an athlete or coach. This volunteer is a one-year term, beginning June 15 each year and reports to Curl BC's Member Services Manager.

Areas of Responsibility

- Organize wheelchair training opportunities for community and competition coaches
 - o Train the Trainer wheelchair curling event
 - o NCCP Wheelchair Curling Module
 - o 1-2 Webinars annually
- Develop a series of wheelchair programs including, but not limited to:
 - Try Wheelchair Curling
 - o 3-5 week Learn to Curl
- Collaborate with local associations and curling clubs to host wheelchair curling events in clubs across BC.
- Mentor community champions
- Liaise at the BC Wheelchair Championship
