

Greater Vernon 2022 BC Winter Games (in 2023) External Travel Planning Summary

*Tentative planning document – subject to change (updated December 7, 2022)

Background

All registered participants who attend the BC Winter or BC Summer Games, except for those who reside in the immediate vicinity of the host community, are provided with the opportunity to travel to the Games on flights or buses chartered by the BC Games Society. This transportation is offered at no additional cost to participants and is one of the major benefits offered to sports who participate in the Games.

Sports are required to select pick-up point information for each participant that they register for the Games. The BC Games Society then works with contractors to plot travel and provide each participant with a travel itinerary detailing their travel arrangements to and from the host community.

To make this transportation network feasible, sports are required to follow the <u>BC Games Society Team Travel Policy</u> and ensure that a zone coach or adult supervisor is present to supervise participants. Additionally, sports are asked to limit the number of pick-up points selected in each zone for their participants. As a regional zone team, participants are expected to travel from their home community to the pick-up point selected by their sport at their own cost. The BC Games Society reserves the right to move participants to other pick-up points within their zone to best achieve an efficient transportation network.

Planning Summary

Those Flying to the Games:

- North West (Zone 7) communities northwest of Vanderhoof/Fort St. James will fly from Terrace
- Cariboo-North East (Zone 8) McLeod Lake and communities northeast will fly from Fort St. John
- All participants on BC Games charter flights will fly to and from Kelowna International Airport.
 Transportation will be provided between the airport and the Bus Arrivals/Departures Area in Greater Vernon.

Those Busing to the Games:

- Kootenays (Zone 1) All of Zone 1 will bus to the Games
- Fraser Valley (Zone 3) All of Zone 3 will bus to the Games
- Fraser River (Zone 4) All of Zone 4 will bus to the Games
- Vancouver-Coastal (Zone 5) All of Zone 5 will bus to the Games
- Vancouver Island-Central Coast (Zone 6) All of Zone 6 will bus to the Games
- North West (Zone 7) Vanderhoof/Fort St. James and communities east will bus to the Games
- Cariboo-North East (Zone 8) communities south of McLeod Lake will bus to the Games

Thompson-Okanagan (Zone 2):

- Participants from the following communities are expected to make their own way to the Games and report to their designated accommodation site by 10:30 am PST to meet up with the rest of their team.
 - South of Sicamous (residents of Sicamous are bused)
 - North of Penticton (residents of Penticton are bused)
 - This includes residents of the municipalities of Armstrong, Coldstream, Enderby, Kelowna, Lake Country, Lumby, Peachland, Salmon Arm, Spallumcheen, Vernon, and West Kelowna.
- These participants should connect with their zone coach to determine their specific arrival time.
- All other Zone 2 participants are provided with transportation on BC Games buses.

Special Travel Zones:

- Participants living in remote areas of British Columbia not serviced by BC Games Society charter flights or buses may be eligible for special travel provisions (i.e.; travel via commercial services).
- Special Travel Zones include remote areas of Zones 6, 7, and 8 such as the Central Coast Regional
 District (including the Bella Coola Valley and surrounding areas), Haida Gwaii, the northern parts of the
 Regional District of Kitimat–Stikine (Dease Lake, etc.), the Stikine Region, and the Northern Rockies
 Regional Municipality.
- If special travel arrangements, as noted above, are required, please select "Special Travel Zone" as the pick-up point of that participant.

Timing and Expectations:

- Participants on BC Games transportation from Vancouver Island-Central Cost (Zone 6) and those on charter flights will travel to Greater Vernon on Wednesday, March 22, 2023, and are expected to arrive that evening.
- All other participants on BC Games charter buses will travel to Greater Vernon on Thursday, March 23, 2023, and are expected to arrive by 12:00 pm PST.
- Those participants making their own way to the Games should plan to arrive at their sport's designated Games accommodation site on Thursday, March 23, 2023. These participants should connect with their zone coach to determine their specific arrival time.
- Returning from the Games, all participants on BC Games transportation will depart Greater Vernon midafternoon on Sunday, March 26, 2023, and arrive at their home destination Sunday night or early Monday morning.
- Those participants making their own way home from the Games should identify a plan for pick-up at a convenient location on Sunday, March 26, 2023. This may include the accommodation site or sport venue for that participant, depending on their schedule for that day.
- Transporting up to 1,400 participants to Vernon takes significant planning, coordination, and cooperation.
 Meeting registration the deadline of February 13, 2023 for all athletes, coaches, and officials on Games transportation is critical.
