 - o Coaches and chaperones do not have to pay this fee.
- Fill out the **BCWG registration form** link that has been emailed to your team contact or coach
 - o This information is used for BC Games to send your participant packages that includes luggage tags, access to your online portal with the BC Games.
 - o **ALL** players, coaches, and chaperones must fill out their information in this form

- Team Chaperones/Supervisors
 - o Must have a valid Criminal Record Check and Complete the online Safe Sport Module
